## Nonprofit Enterprise at Work offers online seminars

Beginning this month, nonprofits can learn more about nonprofit board service and nonprofit technical assessments through Ann Arbor-based **Nonprofit Enterprise at Work's** new online series.

The online seminars are hosted by GoToMeeting, where participants will be able to see the presentation slides on their computer monitors and listen to presenters on the phone.

The sessions include:

- "Essentials of Nonprofit Board Service," scheduled from 10 to 11 a.m., Thurs., Nov. 20. It will focus roles and responsibilities of nonprofit board members. The cost is \$69.
- "Recruiting a Winning Board," from 3 to 4 p.m., Thurs., Nov. 20. The cost is \$69.
- "Cheap but Hardy Tech Solutions," which will review solutions to basic internal needs, such as appropriate e-mail systems, cost-efficient servers and alternatives to hiring IT staff or expensive consultants. It will be from noon to 1 p.m. Mon., Dec. 8. The cost is \$50.
