Former bank exec Michael Tyson new CEO at Ann Arbor-based Nonprofit Enterprise at Work

Nonprofit Enterprise at Work Inc. has named a former **JP Morgan Chase & Co.** executive Michael Tyson as its next president and CEO.

Tyson succeeds Neel Hajra, who left NEW to become COO and vice president for community investment at the **Ann Arbor Area Community Foundation**.

DHR International Inc. consultants in Birmingham conducted the search, following the Ann Arbor Area Community Foundation's appointment of Hajra in June.

Tyson joins NEW, which works with nonprofits in areas including capacity building and board development, from **Residential Detroit Inc.**, a company he founded in 2005 to develop and build residential housing in Detroit.

Prior to that, he was on loan to the city of Detroit from JP Morgan Chase (Bank One at that time) from 2003 to 2005, to help develop a strategy to centralize the city's leasing process for city offices.

Tyson worked for 25 years for the bank now known as JP Morgan Chase, holding a numerous positions including branch manager, manager of retail banking and eventually senior vice president, retail banking for Southeast Michigan.

He earned a bachelor's degree in business administration from **Eastern Michigan University** in 1978.
